We are seeking a full-time or maximum part-time Consultant in Paediatric Nephrology based at Great Ormond Street NHS Trust.

The department is a fully integrated regional and international referral centre for infants and children suffering from all renal diseases, including acute, chronic and end-stage renal failure, congenital renal anomalies, nephrotic syndrome, glomerulonephritis, hypertension, vasculitis, tubular, metabolic and stone disorders. There are very close links with academic paediatric nephro-urology, based in the Institute of Child Health.

The successful candidate will join the team of 6 consultants in offering a comprehensive paediatric nephrology service. With this appointment, the on-call consultant (based on a 1 in 6 rota with prospective cover) will be released from outpatient work whilst on service. Applicants must have experience in paediatric nephrology and a commitment to research. A commitment to teaching would also be welcomed. The successful candidate will be offered an honorary Senior Lectureship, affiliated to the Nephro-Urology Unit in the Institute of Child Health and would be encouraged to establish research links, if appropriate.

All applicants must either be on the General Medical Council's specialist register or be within three months of obtaining their CSST award at the time of application.

Academic interests will be encouraged; research and teaching in collaboration with the Institute of Child Health (University College London) will be expected. Although this post is full time, consideration will be given to applicants who require flexible working arrangements. All applicants for consultant posts must either be on the General Medical Council's Specialist Register or be within six months of obtaining their specialist registration at the time of applying for this post.

The basic salary range for this post is £71,822 to £96,831 per annum plus £2,162 per annum London Weighting.
